Please note the **full dress rehearsal** which means hair, make-up and costumes. A schedule is attached to this letter so that students know the times they are required. We understand many parents work, but would greatly appreciate any that can help out. Parents who are willing to help backstage for this rehearsal and either of the concerts, please notify me via email. A pass will be required to enter backstage. Students are to be dropped at the backstage theatre door.

Students are to arrive 30-45 minutes prior to the concerts with hair and make-up done. Information on hair and make-up will be given out closer to the concert. We will be holding a hair/make up tutorial at the Studio on **Saturday 8th November 9.30 - 10.30am** for any parents wanting assistance.

Students are to arrive at rehearsal and concerts with costumes in a bag - not wearing them!

Please note that these dates and times are allocated to our school by the theatre and totally out of our control and the dates have been in the newsletters since the start of the year. Students from Wednesday and Saturday daytime/pre-school classes, Musical Theatre, and Sub-Junior Acrobatics will not be performing at these concerts (they will perform in the junior concert only).

Students will be required to arrive at the theatre at 9.15am. Tickets will be pre-sold and seats allocated and there will be no limit on the number of tickets per family – order forms are available on separate document on the website and tickets are \$25.00 adults and \$15.00 children (17 and under). Children 2 years and under free of charge – no seat. Tickets are allocated on a first come first serve basis, so please get your orders in asap.

Details of hair and make-up will be given out shortly. We will be holding a hair/make up tutorial at the Studio on **Saturday 8th November 9.30 - 10.30am** for any parents wanting assistance.

There will be no tickets available at the door. Junior Concerts tickets can be ordered by filling out and handing in the form on the website.

The concert will be professionally videoed so you are not permitted to take your own footage. Everyone will receive the link for the concert video as a part of the Concert Package.

The pre-school classes will have a Disco break up Party on Friday 5th December 4.15-5.15pm. The disco will also be open to outside friends.

Costume Account

The remainder of the Costume amounts will be included with the Term 4 fees invoice. All costumes are being hired again this year, so please read carefully the section on "caring for hired costumes".

Please note that costumes will only be given out once term/costume invoices have all been paid for.

Caring for Hired Costumes

Along with some of our own wardrobe, other schools and clubs are also kind enough to hire out their costumes to us so that we always have different and professional costumes at an affordable price. It is very important to care for all costumes and return them in the same condition that we receive them. Please note that costumes are not to be worn other than for photographs and performances – they are not for fancy dress at home or showing family and friends before the big day. It is essential to keep all pieces of the costume together as some have accessories – all costumes and accessories are numbered and recorded and any lost items will be replaced at your expense. Please do not wash the costumes as many have sequins, trims, etc. that can be ruined. On collection of all costumes we will wash them all before returning to the hirer.

PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHS:

We will be having professional photographs with Belinda from 'Belinda's Photography', taken on Saturday 15th November for all classes (junior and principal concerts, and troupes). The schedule for the photographs is at the end of this newsletter. Information for ordering photographs will be emailed. Please arrive with hair and make up done and costumes in a bag. All dancers must have either a body stocking, or for older dancers, skin coloured bra and underwear is also acceptable (especially if two piece costumes or cut outs in costumes). Hair and make up information will be emailed closer to the concerts.

Please note that all students are required to perform in all concerts and that costumes have been organised for each student.

Please note that this is a <u>very tight schedule</u> and is in the order of the concert program. Please print a copy of this for your child and put it in their bag so they can be organised. We have to be packed up and out of the theatre by 7pm. You can sign your child out once they have finished dancing (allow about 15 minutes after their dance time is finished so they have time to be packed up and ready for pick up).

A reminder that you are only required at the rehearsal at the time you are dancing, you can arrive 20 minutes before your first item, and leave once you are done.

Saturday 6th December – 1.00pm Concert (arrive 12.15pm) & 6.30pm Concert (arrive 5.45pm) – you will need to be picked up in between concerts but can leave all your costumes etc at the theatre.
